Our goal is to have a Marriage Discipler in every church, community, and country around the world to help build, enrich, and reconcile marriages.


We want to see marriages move from performance-based to faith-based.

## **MISSION**



# THE JOURNEY TO BURKINA FASO

In the spring of 2021, DG Elmore, friend and chairman of The Navigators Board, called me to talk about Christian Family Life. He wanted to connect me with Gio Llerena, Vice President of Christian Family Life. Gio and I then talked and right away we could tell there was significant overlap with CFL and The Navigators mutual focus on making disciples. I brought Sam Johns, who gives Staff Oversight & Care with our Navigators staff, into the conversation.

We concluded that it would be great if Christian Family Life could serve us in The Navigators in June 2022 by having several trainings with Navigators Staff couples. Most are leaders with the Navigators Disciplemakers Life Mission. Gio and his wife Suzy along with Roland

and his wife Tammy led us through some great training on marriage using their core material. I truly appreciate how the training is grounded in God's intent for marriage as found in the book of Genesis and building marriages with this foundation in mind.

A CFL Team Member put me in touch with Army Chaplain Mike

Smith (now at Ft Bragg) who had returned from Burkina Faso where he had been helping with the training of military chaplains. Mike & I spoke on the phone and he gave me Etienne's contact info. We then exchanged emails in French and I asked The Navigators Country Director if the chaplain and his wife could be invited to two days of the week-long Laborers Camp (held every 3 years) where Karen and I were the principal speakers for the 80+ attendees.

The Burkina Faso Navigators agreed to invite Etienne and his wife. Karen and I met them the first evening and he said he would need to come and go through the week, but he would be present the two days we were to present Two Becoming One (in French). After the first day, he and his wife registered for the whole week and remained with us. Etienne and his wife were particularly encouraging to us personally all week, in and out of meetings, small groups and meals.

We took two days to present the house overview with enthusiastic participation, especially by married & engaged couples. When we gave them the book and workbooks for \$2.65 per set, they were ecstatic and insisted on a group photo with these treasured resources. French biblical resources are rare and costly in Francophone Africa. Having ministered there over 20 years (12.5 as resident missionaries in Côte d' Ivoire), we have never found anything comparable to your marriage materials. When we handed out the sets we asked them to write their names inside each cover and to write in the text their promise as a couple to read the book and finish all the chapters in the workbooks within one year or less.

All the laborers that attended were CIM (conventional income ministers) - teachers, nurses, accountants, etc. - who group together in several regions or provinces throughout Burkina Faso. They have the possibility of reuniting a few times per year in person or by video calls. We encouraged them to prioritize some time to share what they are learning and applying from Two Becoming One when they do have a chance to fellowship together.

You've made an excellent choice in offering Etienne & his wife the ministry opportunity with Two Becoming One. We thank God for the privilege of partnering with CIM in building up the saints in French-speaking Africa in their marriages and the ministries the Lord has entrusted to them all over Burkina Faso.

In the military community where it is difficult to understand the context unless you have served, few resources have penetrated that unseen barrier like the marriage discipleship materials of 2B1. Success in a military context is predominantly from soldier performance. Ironically, success in a Biblical based marriage is centered on Faith

instead of Performance. Thanks to a growing wave of military marriages being transformed by this 2B1 principle, the good news is spreading that a career in uniform doesn't have to equal a failed marriage, but instead a victorious marriage.


However, one of the questions we always get asked is, "What's next?" We plan to answer that question



## **TRAININGS**



The heartbeat of Christian Family Life is found in equipping and resourcing couples to be marriage disciplers. Whether we are doing a conference, retreat, date night, or any other catalytic event, our main focus is found in training couples to invest in other couples. This year we estimate over 200 couples were trained to take the message of FAITH Love and share it with other couples either in groups or individually. Our trainings were held all over the world both in-person and virtually.

We will continue to make this a priority for Christian Family Life and look forward to seeing hundreds more trained and equipped to impact marriages in their communities.

### **RETREATS**

This year our CFL team partnered with Charlotte Leadership Forum and Walking With Warriors ministries to provide a retreat experience for couples they are investing in. At a retreat, we have the opportunity to invest at a more intimate level with couples attending and with the leaders that are guiding them. This is a fairly new initiative for CFL and we are looking forward to growing in the future.

Partnering with these two ministries now gives the leaders the opportunity to follow up and even form a group and walk them through the faith principles on a deeper level.

We are looking forward to adding a few more retreats in 2023!

We are excited to hear about groups popping up all over the world. A small group environment allows couples to come together and build relationships while investing in their marriages.






